Bowl for the Cure® - Laurie Riker No Tap Doubles Tournament Rules

- 1. **Any person, 18 or older, may bowl in this event**. Individuals who are not a sanctioned bowler in the Lansing USBC may purchase a membership but not required to in order to participate.
- 2. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis, being determined as 100% of the difference of the bowler's average of 230. **Sanctioned Bowlers**: Averages will be the highest sanctioned average (of 21 games or more in any county) from the previous season as per Bowl.com (first winter then summer). Sport and challenge averages will be converted per the USBC average conversion sheet. If a bowler does not have an established average from the prior season, they must use their highest current season average. The plus 10 rule is waived. **Non-sanctioned bowlers**: Use highest average on bowl.com within last 5 seasons, if not available then men use 180, and women use 150. *ALL AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED AT CHECK-IN*.
- 3. Teams may consist of any combination of genders. 2 bowlers per team and up to 3 teams per lane.
- 4. Entries submitted by the closing date will ensure an entry into the tournament, limited to 120 teams.

 Lane assignments will be a random draw on a first come first serve basis, based on availability.

 Crossover requests are not guaranteed. If desired, please submit entries together notating the request.

 Walkins may be permitted if lanes are available but are not guaranteed.
- 5. Prizes will be awarded in the form of gift cards graciously donated for this event. 100% of proceeds will be going to Bowl for the Cure. Please show your support for the sponsors and their generosity!
- 6. In the case of a tie for first place, the tiebreaker will be the team head-to-head scores of game 1, then if needed game 2 and then game 3. If still tied, co-champions will be awarded.
- 7. All bowlers shall report to the tournament sign in desk at least 15 minutes prior to bowling to verify averages, line-up, and receive lane assignment.
- 8. These and other rules deemed necessary by the Tournament Management shall govern.
- 9. Prizes shall be distributed the day of the event. Any and all protests/appeals should be shared with the Tournament Director within an hour of the completion of bowling.
- 10. Please be respectful of the establishment. The tournament committee reserves the right to refuse participation to anyone deemed to be inappropriately attired or shows disrespect to the bowling center without recourse. 11. Non-sanctioned bowlers can enter "N/A" as member number and follow average instructions as listed.
